



Covid-19 and SBC

The Covid-19 pandemic has had a huge impact on our club both financially and on the way we function. The club closed its doors for 18 weeks and reopened on the 21st of July.

Our table numbers are slowly climbing but are still quite low compared with previous years. The sanitation procedures continue and probably will for quite some time. Members continue to bring their own hot drinks.

The Club's revenue for 2020 dropped \$61,000 from 2019 and whilst the club also had a reduction in expenses it was to a much lesser extent. The club was very fortunate to receive funding from Brisbane City Council "Lord Mayors Covid-19 Assistance Program" to help offset expenses incurred in the first half of 2020. Alcohol wipes continue to be a large operating cost to the club.

From 1 January 2021, the titles of ranks that used stars in the rank name (eg. ** Local) have their stars replaced by either "bronze" for one-star ranks or "silver" for two-star ranks. This applies to Local, Regional, State and National, and is consistent with terminology used in the upper ranks.
